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








SCORE in BiH










Percent of individuals who have, at least once, engaged in the following activities








Divisive Narratives & Resilience Against Them

SCORE BiH 2020 asked respondents if they disagree or agree various statements and narratives associated with divisive ideologies.

A majority within each ethnic group tends to support ethnonationalist divisive narratives spread by their own ethnic group, while Salafi narratives are not strongly supported.

Support	Opposition

Bosniak Nationalist Narratives	53%	30%
Croat Nationalist Narratives	60%	20%
Serb Nationalist Narratives	65%	21%
Salafi Narratives	22%	57%






Tension with Outgroups

Compared to 2014, interethnic relations are not much better today, with increases in some indicators and decreases in others.

Stereotypes that other groups are Violent



Cultural Distance



feel they do not share common values with other groups

Positive Feelings



In all three ethnic groups there was a decrease in positive feelings by 1/10

Factors affecting Tension and Harmony

Interethnic tensions are driven mainly by Ethnonationalist Ideology, Islamophobia and a perception of cultural difference with other ethnic groups. The main prerequisite for harmony is frequent contact with other ethnic groups.



Divisive Narratives

Positive Citizenship

Relies on **Trust in NGOs** and **awareness** of civic issues. **Critical** media consumption is essential for ensuring that active behaviour is **inclusive**.

Key Messages



Resilience against Ethnonationalism & Violence

Develop civic identity, contact frequency, cultural similarities, tolerant religiosity and healthy social relationships

Civic Engagement

Engagement is **low**, but has increased since 2014, and is higher than other countries





Intergroup Harmony

Increase by focusing on contact, cultural commonalities, and reducing the sway of ethnonationalism and Islamophobia
